PUBLIC SAFETY ALERT

Siksika Public Safety has received a report of suspicious sales that occurred at the Crowfoot NTN community on February 02, 2023. It was reported that 2 Caucasian males came to the reporter's trailer, purporting to be selling security systems on behalf of Brinks. Both were wearing Brinks shirts, and had a laminated Brinks ID card. The reporter observed that they parked their vehicle, described as a mid age black 4 door vehicle with a hatchback (plate unknown), on the road rather than pulling into the neighbourhood and walked in. Lands Management has verified that there is no permit granted to Brinks to operate on the Nation.

The males are described as follows:

Male #1: Caucasian, older, having short red hair and beard;

Male #2: Caucasian, younger, shoulder length blond hair.

Vehicle is described as black, 4-door mid age vehicle with a hatchback. A license plate was not obtained.

Please do not allow door to door sales people into your homes, as the Nation does not permit such activity. Report any suspicious activity immediately to Public Safety at **403-734-3815**.
