POSITION SUMMARY:

The Community Peace Officer is responsible for enforcing the provision of By-Laws passed by Chief & Council and enforcing the provision of appointed statutes under the Peace Officer appointment as laid out by the Solicitor General. This position assists and works cooperatively with the RCMP, Fish and Wildlife, Parks, and other allied policing agencies, Siksika Nation Administration area partners, internal Siksika Nation Administration departments and the community. This position investigates By-Law complaints and disputes, and ensures appropriate resolutions either by fine, order and/or education. Patrols the community through shift work on a regular basis for enforcement, prevention, and education of all offences related to their appointment.

DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES: *Duties include but not limited to:*

- Provide assistance to Animal Control Services and Security Services.
- Provide a liaison with the RCMP and other policing agencies.
- Complete necessary investigations and related procedures.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

Required Knowledge, Skills, and Abilities:

- Making decisions evaluative in nature that assesses risk that are timely, decisive, and effective.
- Making decisions that recognizes the Collaborative Policing Model.
- Implementing organization and unit policies, procedures, guidelines, and programs.
