POSITION SUMMARY:

The Solid Waste Truck Operator is a critical role within the Siksika Nation's Public Works Department, dedicated to ensuring the cleanliness, health, and environmental sustainability of the community. The operator is responsible for the safe and efficient collection, transportation, and disposal of solid waste while maintaining and operating waste collection vehicles and equipment. This position requires professionalism, attention to detail, and the ability to engage respectfully with Nation members and other Siksika Nation Tribal Administration staff. The role also emphasizes adherence to operational and safety standards, supporting the overall infrastructure and environmental goals of the Siksika Nation.

DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES: *Duties include but are not limited to:*

- Daily servicing of solid waste trucks and maintaining service logs.
- Conducting pre- and post-trip vehicle and equipment inspections daily, maintaining logs accordingly.
- Picking up solid waste as per schedule or on request.
- Responding to Nation members' requests and work orders via City Reporter.
- Following collection routes and reporting findings or incidents as they arise.
- Using computers, phones, and tablets to track routes and report incidents effectively.
- Being available 24/7 for emergency on-call duties.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

Required Knowledge, Skills, and Abilities

- Ability to follow written and oral instructions effectively.
- Capable of working independently with limited supervision.
- Strong teamwork and communication skills.
- Proficient with technology, including computers, phones, and tablets.
- Strong interpersonal skills to interact with community members and staff professionally.

- Adherence to operational and administrative policies.
