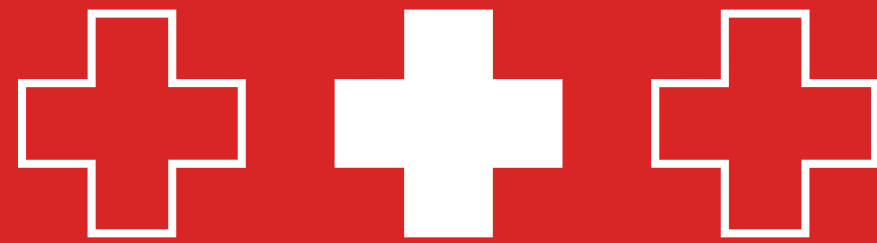




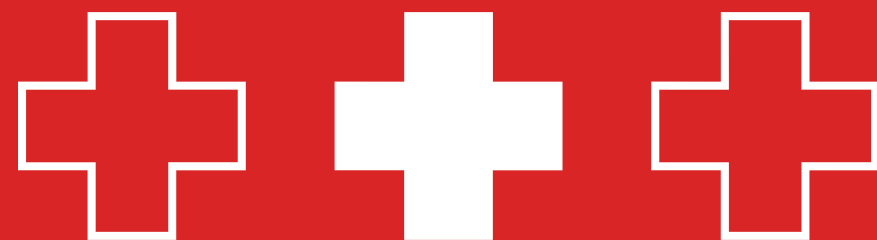
COMPREHENSIVE COMMUNITY PLAN (CCP)

Phase 3: Empower and Collaborate

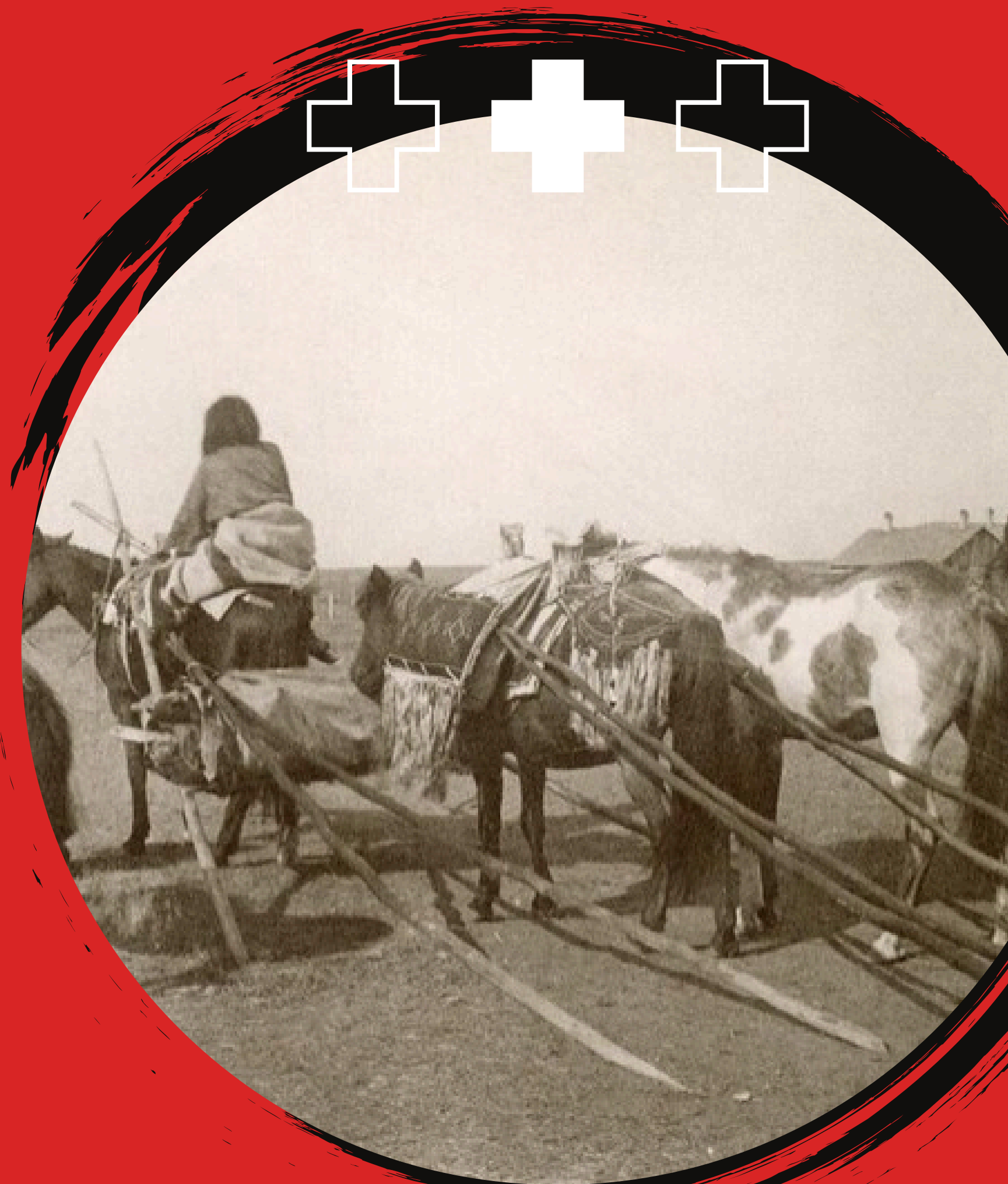


Phase 4: Create and Finalize
