POSITION SUMMARY:

The Environment Field Technician will conduct field encumbrance review focusing on environmental and water management protection for land use requests and activities. Focus on plant, wetland, wildlife, environmental assessments, soil classification, detailed site assessment reports and other related activities. Assist In the development, execution, and maintenance of an Environmental Management Plan, Waste Management Plan, Water, and/or Riparian Plan.

DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES: *Duties include but are not limited to:*

- Conduct compliance inspections of residential, construction, agricultural, industrial, grazing and resource related activities in accordance with land use agreements and applicable environment laws, regulations, guidelines and/or bylaws.
- Assess proposed land use interest from Siksika members, various departments and entities, companies, and contractors to ensure environmental protection practices including but not limited to, traditional ecological knowledge (TEK) and protection of Siksika environment and cultural / historical sites are addressed, assist in identifying and correcting environment noncompliance regarding land, water and/or resources sites and activities.
- Identify historical and current environment noncompliance sites and provide remediation measures.
