POSITION SUMMARY:

The Pilot Project Program Manager case worker is a proactive professional who supports individuals and families in accessing culturally appropriate and coordinated services through the Pilot Project. This initiative focuses on improving access to services for Siksika Nation citizens by identifying service gaps, promoting substantive equality, and supporting individual-centered planning.

DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES: *Duties include but are not limited to:*

- Manage a caseload of clients assigned by the Case Manager.
- Develop individualized MyCompass Plans with individuals and the individual's support team in collaboration with service providers.
- Build positive, respectful relationships with clients and their support teams.
- Engage clients and support teams in the planning and decision-making process.
- Work collaboratively with Siksika Nation departments and service providers.
- Develop and maintain protocols and relationships with key partners (e.g., the Blood Tribe and the Piikani Nation).
- Attend team meetings and professional development sessions.
- Comply with all applicable Siksika Nation policies and procedures.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

Required Knowledge, Skills, and Abilities

- Problem-solving, mediation, and conflict resolution skills.
- Proficiency in the MyCompass application, sufficient to orient and coach other users.
- Ability to maintain confidentiality over personal issues and information.
- Knowledge of case management and social work principles and current case management systems and tools.
- Knowledge of current provincial and federal funding programs applicable to adults with disabilities.
- Understanding of social barriers, cultural diversity, and disability impacts.
- Strong organizational and time management skills.

A Bachelor of Social Work or related discipline.

Minimum of five years of relevant work experience in a First Nations community.

Proven management experience with operational, budgetary, and financial planning experience.
