

This will be followed by temperatures quickly dropping below zero in some areas, likely causing any wet surfaces to freeze.

Brief periods of freezing rain or blowing snow are also possible in parts of central Alberta tonight.

Icy surfaces may form quickly and be difficult to detect. High sided vehicles may be blown around by the wind.

In flurries, visibility may we quickly and suddenly reduced to near zero. Consider rescheduling travel and outdoor activities.
