SIKSIKA LAND USE INVENTORY SURVEY



Data capture from membership is required across several land use areas. For ranching and grazing, this includes livestock numbers and identification, rancher contact information, community pasture use, and the identification of private pastures. Agricultural data collection covers land use types, acreage for farming and hay or feed production, contact information for agricultural users, and the locations of farmland used by Nation members. Information on private tourism land use includes the locations of tourism activities, the types of tourism conducted, and any structures present. Cultural land use data focuses on identifying cultural sites, their general locations and sizes, and the protection measures in place.

SIKSIKA ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT SURVEY



Phase 1 of our study focuses on identifying locations that may be impacted by past or present land uses, helping to inform both short-term and long-term land use planning.

This assessment reviews whether activities on the site or nearby—such as gas stations, dump sites, or chemical storage—may pose potential or actual environmental concerns.

Because environmental harm can come from surrounding properties as well as the site itself, Phase 1 helps identify areas that may require further attention.

Your input is valuable, and community feedback plays an important role in shaping responsible land use decisions.
