The Security Guard is a part of a security team; working both day and night shifts on weekdays, weekends, and holidays, its primary role is to patrol Siksika Nation and ensuring the safety of the Siksika people as well as maintaining the security of Siksika lands.

2. Actively patrol all Siksika Nation communities, buildings and other structures including parking compound lots and community centers and check in at designated patrol locations.
3. Report and assist the Animal Services unit with removal of stray, uncontrolled or
4. abused/malnourished animals from undesired conditions.
5. Report criminal activity to the Police, Security Supervisor and provide assistance as requested.
