IMPORTANT NOTICE TO RESIDENTS

PLEASE PREPARE BEFORE CREWS ARRIVE

ACCEPTED ITEMS:

Please place acceptable large items by the roadside before crews arrive. Examples include:

- Furniture
- Mattresses
- Appliances
- Scrap metal
- Bagged clothing
- Large household items

ITEMS WE WILL NOT PICK UP

For the health and safety of workers, crews **WILL NOT** collect:

- Loose or unbagged clothing
- Vehicle batteries
- Hazardous waste
- Tires
- Chemicals or paint
- Needles or biomedical waste
- Animal carcasses
- Propane tanks
- Construction debris or demolition materials
- Broken glass or sharp materials not safely contained
- Items too heavy or unsafe to lift

DOG SAFETY NOTICE

Please ensure all dogs are tied up or secured before crews arrive. Free-roaming dogs may affect the quality and efficiency of service provided to your area and neighboring homes.

PLEASE NOTE

Public Works crews WILL NOT:

- Take service requests unrelated to the clean up
- Respond to issues for other departments
- Clean private yards or private property

Residents are responsible for moving items to the roadside collection area.
