



TREATY 7 ANNIVERSARY

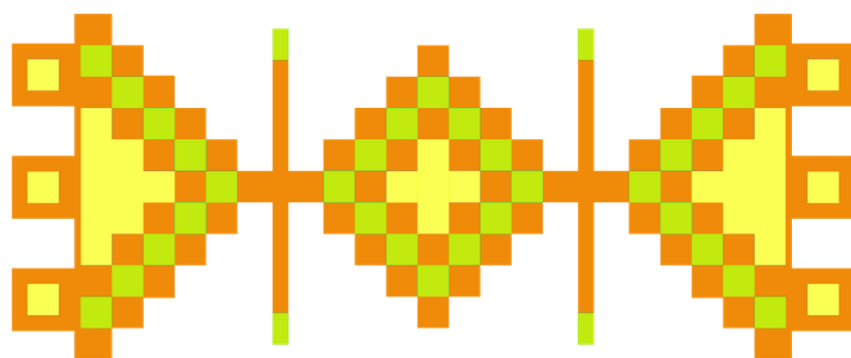
HAPPY SIKSIKA DAY!
